Club Service Report:

Edy reported - None

International Service Report: Debbie reported that the \$14,000 budget for 2021-2022 would be used for:

- Polio Plus \$2,000
- **Davs for Girls -** \$5.000
- **Shelter Box (Tigray) \$1,000**
- **District Grant (hand washing stations)** \$1,000. The committee will be applying for a \$24,000 District Grant; deadline is in September. Debbie has reached out to 11 clubs for funding and is scheduled for two presentations.
- Global Grant Janet and Debbie are looking at doing another Global Grant to further strengthen the Days for Girls ESwatini sewing center.
- **Technomodo in Columbia, South America -** \$2,000, which was carried over from last year's budget.
- **Other Projects** \$5,000

Old Business:

- Membership Young Professionals and Golden Years Recommendation:
 - O Young Professionals (under 36 years old) a \$1,000 scholarship could be awarded on a case by case basis. Also, we need to do more in PR to attract young people.
 - Honorary Age-based at 85 years old; reduce dues; private application to apply for Honorary membership.
- **Motion:** Casey moved to accept recommendations; Jeff seconded; motion passed with the stipulation that above membership parameters needed for next Board meeting.
